1. Course abstract

Semester: 2.

Volume of the module: total number of hours – 180 of them: lectures – 24 hours, practical – 48 hours, independent work – 108 hours; number of ECTS – 6,0.

The purpose of the course is formation of students' system of theoretical and practical knowledge about categories, concepts, methods of economics and corporate governance.

Learning outcomes of the discipline:

know: basic economic laws; basics of doing business in Ukraine and the world; organizational and legal forms of corporate business; external and internal factors of influence; legal bases of business in Ukraine; types of corporate enterprises; regulatory framework for investment activities; investment classification; methods of regulation; principles of foreign investment; tax conditions; methods of assessing economic efficiency, methods of assessing the value of corporations and its components in different markets; corporate business culture;

be able to: apply methods of scientific knowledge; assess the value of the corporation and prospects for expanding its activities; substantiate management decisions; apply the principles of doing business; choose the optimal organizational and legal form of corporate business; to organize the movement of tangible and intangible values;

have the skills: conducting research; modern methods and tools of doing business; skills of concluding contracts; methods of evaluating partners in the business environment; skills to solve problems independently; teamwork skills, business communication; legal and economic information retrieval skills; ability to identify benefits; ability to identify various factors; skills of building interpersonal communications with staff and the environment;

able to demonstrate: systematic theoretical knowledge of economics and corporate governance; combination of theoretical and practical knowledge in substantiation of management decisions of corporate business taking into account the needs and interests of all parties.

Required training components (prerequisites, co-requisites, post-requisites):

enterprise economics, global economy, international enterprise competitiveness.

Course content: Topic 1. Corporation and its place among business associations of Ukraine. Topic 2. Corporate governance. Topic 3. Mechanisms of corporate governance. Topic 4. Strategic management of the corporation. Topic 5. Capital management of the corporation. Topic 6. Management of the movement of corporate securities. Topic 7. Depository system and its role in corporate regulation. Topic 8. The stock market and its role in the management of corporate capital. Topic 9. Corporate control. Topic 10. The effectiveness of corporate governance.

Forms of final control: examine (semester 1).

Means of diagnosing learning success: individual tasks, exercises, list of questions, sets of test tasks for thematic and final controls.

Language of instruction: Ukrainian.

Exam evaluation criteria

The exam is conducted through the Modular environment of the educational process KNUTD in the form of tests of final control. 30 questions of 0.33 points were passed for the exam for each correct answer.

3. Course policy:

3.1 Mandatory observance of academic integrity by students, namely:

- independent performance of all types of work, tasks, forms of control provided by the working program of this discipline;
- links to sources of information in the case of the use of ideas, developments, statements, information;
- compliance with the law on copyright and related rights;
- providing reliable information about the results of their own educational (scientific, creative) activities, used research methods and sources of information.

3.2 To obtain a positive grade in the discipline it is necessary to obtain a minimum number of points for each completed practical task and two modular controls.

3.3 In case of untimely performance of works it is allowed to finish them within time, before passing of modular control on discipline.

3.4 Postponement of delivery / re-submission:

- allowed for good reasons (hospital, academic mobility, etc.) without reducing scores for each completed practical task and two modular controls;
- without good reason is evaluated by 2 points below for each completed practical task and two modular controls.

3.5 When plagiarism is detected, the student's completed practical tasks are not credited. He has the opportunity to retake them, but with a reduction of the score by 50% of the score for each completed practical task.

3.6 Missed practical classes and failed module tests are completed by the student within the semester in which the discipline is taught, by separate agreement with the teacher. Postponement of the deadline for submission of works is in accordance with paragraph 3.4 of the syllabus.

3.7 An appeal by a student of the final grade in the discipline is allowed. Its review is submitted for consideration to a specially created commission at the department consisting of the head and 2 teachers of the department.
