1. Course description

Semester: 7

Scope: total number of hours - 90 of them lectures - 24 hours, practical - 24 hours, independent work - 42 hours; number of ECTS credits - 3.

Course objectives – mastering competencies/abilities on effective management of competitiveness of the enterprises and the organizations, maintenance of competitive advantages of subjects of managing taking into account globalization processes in economy.

Learning outcomes of the course:

know: the essence and content of competitiveness management; model of five competition forces in the industry; factors influencing the competitiveness of the enterprise; competitive advantage management; the relationship and interaction of product competitiveness, competitive advantage and competitiveness of the enterprise; conditions for ensuring high quality and efficiency of management decisions in the system of enterprise competitiveness management.

be able: to analyze the competitive advantages of different objects; to analyze the activities of competitors and forecast the position of enterprises in the market; build a competitive market map and systematize competitive advantages; choose the nomenclature of parameters used in assessing competitiveness; choose comparison bases for assessing competitiveness; use the results of the analysis in the development of competitive strategies of the enterprise; determine the directions of planning and develop programs to increase the competitiveness of the enterprise; systematically manage quality in the enterprise.

able to demonstrate: ability to assess the level of competitiveness of products and enterprises, the ability to justify the formation of strategies for competitive behavior of enterprises and organizations in the market.

have the skills: solving management problems that arise when ensuring the competitiveness of products and enterprises; conducting strategic analysis of various objects; generalization and identification of competitive advantages of different objects; use of integrated assessment of product and enterprise competitiveness; making competitive management decisions in the control subsystem; combination of different methods and development of optimal measures to increase the competitiveness of different facilities.

solve independently: the choice of methods for assessing the level of competitiveness of products and enterprises; selection and substantiation of competition strategies of enterprises and organizations.

Required educational components (prerequisites, co-requisites, post-requisites): business economics, management, operational management, management decisions theory, sustainable development management, personnel management, quality management, creative management

Course content: Topic 1. Competition as an economic category. Topic 2.Competitive environment of the enterprise. Topic 3. The economic essence of enterprise competitiveness. Topic 4. A systematic approach to managing the competitiveness of the enterprise. Topic 5. Methods of assessing the competitiveness of products and enterprises. Topic 6. Development of competitive strategy of enterprises. Topic 7. Programs to increase the competitiveness of the enterprise. Topic 8. Quality management as a basis for ensuring the competitiveness of the enterprise.

Forms of final control: exam (semester 7).

Tools for diagnosing learning success: individual tasks, questions for current control, tests, tasks, calculation works, questions for final control.

Language of instruction: Ukrainian, English

3. Course policy:

- 3.1. Mandatory observance of academic integrity by students, namely:
