Raising and valuation of capital

Level of higher education: first (bachelor).

Speciality: – 076 Entrepreneurship, trade and exchange activities

Educational program – Entrepreneurship and commercial activity.

Discipline status – obligatory.

1. Course annotation

Semester: 7.

Module volume: total number of hours – 180, of them: lectures – 24 hours; practical – 36 hours, individual work – 120 hours; number of ECTS credits – 6.

The purpose of the course - Acquisition of competencies in the analysis of opportunities and needs of business financing, application of methods of raising capital and its evaluation for financial support of business activities, in particular in the conditions of starting your own business.

The results of discipline' studying:

to know: the essence of capital and entrepreneurship, legal restrictions on operation business, forms of financial support of business in the conditions of increase of economic growth rates in Ukraine, features of application of methods of attraction capital at the enterprise, the main sources and methods of raising loans, the essence of leasing, venture and joint ventures and free economic zone;

be able: to analyze the financial needs of entrepreneurship and opportunities for formation of capital, to apply methods of raising and valuing capital in order to provide economic development of the enterprise, to introduce new forms of entrepreneurship, which contribute to the attraction of external and internal capital in business;

be able to demonstrate: the ability to identify the main sources of formation and use of business capital, the specifics of the operation of enterprises, skills of application of methods of formation and estimation of the capital of the enterprise, the ability to identify sources and ways to raise loans in business, to determine the cost of capital and methods of profit formation of the enterprise;

to possess the skills in: raising additional funds in business and building cost of capital, introduction of new forms of entrepreneurship with involvement of external and internal capital;

to solve independently: financial needs of entrepreneurship and opportunities for the formation of its capital; mechanism for attracting and managing the capital of the enterprise, the algorithm of financial controlling.

Required training components (prerequisites, co-requisites, post-requisites): organization of production, economics and organization of innovation, financial management, economic analysis, corporate finance.

Course content: Topic 1. Capital - the economic basis for the creation and development of the enterprise. Topic 2. Raising capital and sources of financing your own business. Topic 3. Bank lending. Topic 4. Loan capital management. Topic 5. Lending in a credit union. Topic 6. Leasing as a source of funds. Topic 7. State and special programs for financing small and medium-sized businesses. Topic 8. Decision-making based on capital valuation.

Types of training lessons: lecture, practical, consultation.

Forms of final control: exam (Semester 7).

Tools for diagnosing studying success: individual tasks, questions for independent work, questions for current control, list of thematic questions, tests, tasks, calculation works, exercises, questions for thematic, modular and final control.

Language of studying: Ukrainian

3. Course policy:

3.1 Mandatory observance of academic integrity by students, namely:

- independent execution of all types of work, tasks, forms of control provided by the work program of this discipline;
- links to sources of information in the case of the use of ideas, developments, statements, information;

- compliance with the law on copyright and related rights;
- providing reliable information about the results of their own educational activities, used research methods and sources of information.

3.2. Current control is carried out during practical classes and aims to check the level of readiness of higher education students to perform specific work. The object of current control of knowledge are: oral reports, results of blitz-surveys, solving problems in practical classes; attending lectures and activity at them; performing tasks for self-study.

3.3. After each content module, a control event is held in the form of a modular test to check the level of assimilation of material by students. Execution of modular tests is a mandatory measure of the boundary section of students' knowledge, which allows the lecturer to orient in the directions and forms of further work and teaching the discipline. For students, this event helps to consolidate the knowledge of a particular content module and accumulate points.

3.4. Works that are submitted in violation of deadlines without valid reason are evaluated at a lower grade. Rearrangement of modules takes place with the permission of the lecturer if there are valid reasons.

3.5. Attendance is mandatory. All class absences are completed by oral recomposition of the topic and performance of missed classes. For objective reasons (for example, illness, international internship) training can take place individually (in agreement with the dean of the faculty).

3.6. Student may appeal the final grade in the discipline. Its review is submitted for consideration to a specially created commission at the department consisting of the head and two teachers of the department.
